Thursday Jan 22 7.00 am: Weinam Creek , Redland Bay.

- **UBD 246 M2/3; Lat, Long:-27.629557, 153.303579.**
- Meet in carpark between Redland Bay Men's Shed (**off School of Arts Rd**) and the Donald Rd Sportsfield (**but DO NOT PUT Donald Rd into your GPS as it will take you to the wrong location!**)
- An easy flat walk along the creek through local parks. Highlight is seeing the dozens of nesting egrets.
- Please carry plenty of water and wear sunscreen, a hat, insect repellent and enclosed shoes.
- Morning tea at the Pelican Cafe (293 Esplanade, Redland Bay).

Thursday Feb 26 7 am Sandy Camp Wetlands, Wynnum West.

- UBD 142 Q16; Lat, long. -27.435318, 153.146308
- Meet at the car park at 115 Sandy Camp Rd (opposite Iona College sports field).
- Easy flat walking in this excellent birding spot.
- This is a 3 hour circuit so please carry water and a snack and wear sunscreen, a hat, insect repellent and enclosed shoes.
- No facilities here so we will drive to Pelicans Nest Cafe - 143 The Esplanade, Wynnum, opposite Wynnum wading pool.

Thursday March 26 7.30 am: King Island, Wellington Point

- UBD 165 C10 Lat, long: 27.46693, 153.23907.
- Meet at the car park at end of Main Rd (on the left facing King Island), Wellington Point Recreation Reserve.
- Please wear waterproof shoes or sandals as we will be walking through shallow water and on sand to get out to King Island and beyond.
- Bring water and wear sunscreen, a hat and insect repellent.
- Bring morning tea and a chair. Coffee is also available at the cafe at the Point.

Thursday April 23 7.15 am Eagleby Wetlands, near the end of Logan St, Eagleby.

- UBD 264 N16 Lat, long: -27.707345, 153.226456
- **Directions:** From the north, exit the Pacific Motorway at Exit 34 and take the second exit at the roundabout onto Saverin Rd. Follow this road into Logan St, through the traffic lights and 1.5 km later turn left into Oliver Sports Complex/ Eagleby wetlands. After 200m turn right to reach the carpark on the right.
- **This is a 3 hour circuit so please carry water and a snack and wear insect repellent, hat and sunscreen.** Bring morning tea and a chair.

- UBD162 B17 Lat, long: -27.482464, 153.115010
- Meet at carpark near lagoon at end of Stanton Rd West (Note this is on the western side of the Gateway Motorway and off Graystone St)
- Bring water, morning tea and a chair in case the picnic tables are all occupied.
- Easy flat walking around lagoons.

- UBD 223 H1 Lat, long: -27.58269, 153.17319
- Meet at the end of Longton Ct, off Leacroft Rd, Burbank.
- Mostly flat but some hilly sections walking on bush tracks through tall forest.
- No facilities here so for morning tea we will drive a short distance to the Koala Bushland Visitor Centre on Alperon Rd.

- UBD205 Q2/3 Lat. Long: -27.540478, 153.272304
- meet at **the Cricket grounds carpark, Fitzroy St, Cleveland** (just south of Baypark Court). **Note: no access via Long St or Beach St as there are a number of no through roads here including Fitzroy St south of Beach St.**
- Bring morning tea and a chair. Also wear a hat, insect repellent and sunscreen and bring water.
