About the Trail

Campbells Creek Trail is a shared gravel path that follows the creek. The surface is mostly dirt with some fine gravel, so we recommend wearing sturdy shoes with good grip. The path is mostly gentle but includes a few short, steep sections.

What to Bring / Wear

Binoculars aren't essential but can enhance the experience. We'll provide tips on using them, and a limited number will be available to borrow on the day. Please bring: weather appropriate clothing, sturdy shoes, binoculars, water and snacks
